5. Procedural Resolutions

- (A) **Regular Board Meeting** will be scheduled for the second and fourth Wednesdays of each month at 7pm.
- (B) Special Meetings may be called by the Mayor or a majority of the Board Members. A Legal Notice will be place in the designated newspaper if time allows. Otherwise, notices will be posted in three locations in the Village. Board Members will be notified of the meeting by phone from the member(s) calling the meeting.

- (C) Authorization for advance approval of claims for the following charges: Postage, Freight & Express charges, Public Utility Services, Petty Cash, Insurance.
- (D) Establishment of Petty Cash Fund and Designate Custodians

In accordance with Section 5-526 of the New York State Village Law, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Livonia hereby establishes the following petty cash funds:

General Fund - \$100.00

The Board of Trustees appoints the Village/Clerk Treasurer and the Deputy Clerk as custodians of the petty cash accounts for the 2021-2022 fiscal year. The petty cash funds and the designation of custodians will be re-established each year at the annual meeting of the Board of Trustees.

These funds will be operated according to the following criteria:

Expenditures will be made only for payment, in advance of audit and upon receipt of properly itemized bills for materials, supplies or services furnished to the Village and upon terms calling for cash payment to the vendor upon delivery. Expenditures from the petty cash will not exceed \$25.00. Sales tax will not be reimbursed.

A list of expenditures made from such petty cash account together with the bills supporting such expenditures, must be presented periodically to the Board of Trustees for audit. The Board must then direct the Village Treasurer to reimburse the petty cash account from the appropriate budgetary item in the amount equal to the audited bills. If any such bills, of portion thereof, are disallowed upon audit, it is the personal liability of the petty cash accounts from which the payment was made. Such custodian shall promptly reimburse the petty cash account equal to the amount disallowed.
