Mayor Lathan stated that at this time the meeting was open for the Public Hearings of Local Law #1-2021 and the Village of Livonia Budget 2021-2022.

Approve Minutes

This is the outline that was shared with LCSWA:

Outline for Village of Livonia/LCSWA operation and maintenance of the water system

- The LCWSA will take over the Village water system, but will keep the Village customers on the same rate schedule
 and unit basis that they currently have. So the Village customers will not see a change. Ultimately, Village
 customers should be billed the same as all the rest of LCWSA customers but right now the units are measured
 differently.
- The LCWSA will transfer \$40,000 per year to the Village until 2028 or the term of the debt service, whichever is earlier.
- The LCWSA will take care of the project costs related to the work at the intersection of Big Tree and Shelly, before
 estimated to be approximately \$60,000 to the Village.
- The LCWSA will take care of the project costs related to the replacement of the services along Shelly, before estimated to be approximately \$40,000 to the Village.
- The LCWSA will take care of the \$52,495 the Village still owes related to the Meadow Drive water project.
- Village customers will share in the upcoming capital project with the other LCWSA customers, which will lead to a
 rate increase in a few years, but that rate increase will be equal across all LCSWA customers.

LOCAL LAW #1-2021

fassed 4/28/2021

Village of Livonia, County of Livingston

A local law amending certain portions of Article 3 of the Code of the Village of Livonia, restricting certain vehicles on the Village highways and parking lots.

Section 1. Legislative Intent

It is the intent of this local law to prevent the use of the Village streets and parking lots by unlicensed, uninspected, or uninsured motor vehicles.

Section 2. Legislative Authority

This local law is enacted pursuant to the Village Law and General Municipal Law of the State of New York for the control and safety of the residents of the Village of Livonia with regard to motor vehicles on village streets and parking lots.

Section 3. Code changes.

Sections 142-14 and 142-21 of the Code of the Village of Livonia are hereby replaced and superceded in their entirety and replaced with the following provisions:

142-14. Certain vehicles restricted.

Any vehicle that is not properly licensed, inspected or insured is not permitted on any Village Street. Also, the parking of any truck, tractor, tractor trailer, trailer body, mobile home, house trailer, boat trailer, camper trailer, bus or any similar vehicle or piece of equipment is not permitted on any Village street or right-of-way at any time.

142-21. Certain vehicles restricted.

Any vehicle that is not properly licensed, inspected or insured is not permitted in any Village parking lot at any time. Also, the parking of any truck, tractor, tractor trailer, trailer body, mobile home, house trailer, boat trailer, camper trailer, bus or any similar vehicle or piece of equipment is not permitted in any Village parking lot at any time.

Section 4. Severability

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstances, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
